AUM vision is to be a leading higher education institution in Kuwait and the region, providing students with an engaging learning environment that is global, ethical and technology rich in a state of the art campus. AUM has two colleges; a College of Engineering and Technology and a College of Business Administration, in addition to a Liberal Arts Department and an English Preparatory Program.



From humble beginnings, a small building and only hundreds of enrolled students in the first few years, AUM became within the last 10 years a landmark in the private education sector in Kuwait and the region through its curricula, its integrated campus and its educational philosophy.

Today, AUM has more than 10,400 enrolled fulltime students, and a university campus that stretches over 261,190 square meters and is considered as the largest and most beautiful among private university campuses in the region.
